Adding them yields $26x = 56$!' $x = 56/26 = 28/13$. Substituting back, $3(28/13) + 4y = 12$!' $84/13 + 4y = 12$!' $4y = 12 - 84/13 = (156 - 84)/13 = 72/13$!' $y = 18/13$. Therefore, $x + y = (28 + 18)/13 = 46/13$ "H 3.54.
