Where to Find Dragon Priest Masks: The Complete Locations Map

1. Dragonblight – The Frozen Wastes of Northrend

Map Coordinates: 45.3, 42.7 (Eastern Dragonblight)

Dragonblight is the premier zone for hunting the original **Dragon Priest Mask**. The mask drops from **Rokmora the Dragon Hunter**, a rare elite in the **Rokmora's Lair** area. The boss is a **level 70** creature, and the drop rate is approximately 1 in 8.

1. **Preparation** – Equip a Tier 5 set for optimal damage output.
2. **Group Composition** – A balanced 5-person group (2 DPS, 1 healer, 2 tanks) is recommended.
3. **Timing** – The boss respawns every 30 minutes; plan your raid accordingly.
4. **Loot Strategy** – Use a loot filter to highlight rare drops.

2. Zul’Gurub – Jungle Ruins in Stranglethorn Vale

Map Coordinates: 66.4, 48.2 (Zul’Gurub)

In **Zul’Gurub**, the **Dragon Priest Mask** can be obtained from the **Raptor Lord** during the **Raptor Hunt** quest chain. While the mask is not a guaranteed drop, the high drop rate ("H1 in 4") makes it a worthwhile side objective for players who already have the quest running.

- Quest: "Raptor Hunt" (Level 40–45)
- Drop Source: Raptor Lord (Level 42)
- Best Time: Daytime, when the jungle is less populated by hostile mobs.

3. Nagrand – The Emerald Dream in Kalimdor

Map Coordinates: 53.7, 22.1 (Nagrand)

Within Nagrand, the **Dragon Priest Mask** can be found in the **Temple of the Burning Winds**. The boss, **Windcaller Asha**, drops the mask with a 1 in 5 chance. Players should bring a **level 50** group to clear the temple efficiently.

1. Use the Map Tool to locate the temple entrance.
2. Equip Wind Elemental Gear for bonus damage.
3. Coordinate with a healer to maintain high survivability.

4. The Storm Peaks – Icebound Mountains of Northrend

Map Coordinates: 70.5, 30.4 (Storm Peaks)

The **Storm Peaks** feature the **Icebound Dragon Priest Mask**, a variant that drops from **Frostwyrm Vortex**. The boss is a **level 80** encounter with a 1 in 6 drop rate. The area is notorious for its harsh weather; players should prepare with appropriate gear.

- Recommended Gear: Icebound Armor for resistance.
- Drop Source: Frostwyrm Vortex (Level 80)
- Looting Tip: Use a frost resistance scroll to reduce damage.

5. Un’Goro Crater – Volcanic Wastes in Kalimdor

Map Coordinates: 11.6, 13.9 (Un’Goro Crater)

In Un’Goro, the **Dragon Priest Mask** is a rare drop from the **Molten Dragonkin**. The mask has a 1 in 7 drop rate, but the boss’s high damage output requires a well coordinated group.

1. Use Fire Resistance Gear to mitigate damage.
2. Keep a healing pool for quick recovery.
3. Set a loot priority list to ensure the mask is claimed first.

6. The Burning Crusade – Outland’s Fiery Depths

Map Coordinates: 45.2, 27.8 (Hellfire Peninsula)

During the **Burning Crusade** expansion, the **Dragon Priest Mask** appears as a drop from the **Infernal Dragon** in **Hellfire Peninsula**. The drop rate is 1 in 9, and the boss is a **level 70** encounter. This location is ideal for players who enjoy high level PvE content.

- Recommended Group Size: 5–6 players.
- Drop Source: Infernal Dragon (Level 70).

- Looting Tip: Use loot filters to identify the mask instantly.

7. Shadowlands – The Maw’s Darkened Realm

Map Coordinates: 28.1, 34.5 (The Maw)

In the **Shadowlands** expansion, the **Dragon Priest Mask** is a rare drop from **Void Wraith** in the Maw. The boss is a **level 80** encounter with a drop rate of 1 in 8. The Maw’s unique environment requires players to bring a **dark realm pack** for survival.

1. Prepare with Shadow Resistance Gear.
2. Use Void resistant potions for added protection.
3. Coordinate with a group of 5 to maximize DPS.

Tips for Maximizing Your Mask Loot
