2. Prerequisites for Jailbreaking Apple TV 3

1. Open a terminal (macOS) or command prompt (Windows).
2. Navigate to a directory where you want to store the jailbreak files. For example: `cd ~/Desktop`.
3. Clone the repository: `git clone https://github.com/AppleTVJailbreak/AppleTVJailbreak.git`.
4. Navigate into the cloned directory: `cd AppleTVJailbreak`.

3.3 Connecting Your Apple TV 3

- Ensure your Apple TV is connected to the same Wi Fi network as your computer.
- Power on the Apple TV and navigate to Settings !' Network !' Wi Fi to confirm the connection.

3.4 Running the Jailbreak Script

With the repository cloned and the device connected, run the jailbreak script. The exact command may vary depending on the tool's documentation. For AppleTVJailbreak, use:

```
python3 jailbreak.py
```

Follow on screen prompts. The script will:

- Detect the Apple TV's OS version.
- Download the necessary exploit payload.
- Inject the payload into the device.
- Install the jailbreak framework and necessary tweaks.

During the process, your Apple TV may reboot several times. Do not interrupt the power or network connection.

3.5 Verifying the Jailbreak

Once the script completes, you should see a message indicating success. To confirm:

- Open the App Store on Apple TV. A new option, "Cydia," should appear. This is the jailbreak package manager.
- Launch Cydia. If it opens, your device is successfully jailbroken.
- Optionally, open a terminal on your computer and run `ssh root@`. The default password is usually `apple` (check the documentation).

4. Post Jailbreak Essentials

4.1 Installing Cydia and Basic Tweaks

Cydia is the primary package manager for jailbroken Apple TV. It allows you to browse, install, and manage tweaks and apps. Here are some recommended tweaks:

- Apple TV Theme Pack: Customize the home screen layout.

Root access can expose your device to threats. Protect your Apple TV by:

- Changing the default root password immediately after the jailbreak.
- Installing a reputable VPN tweak.
- Disabling services you don't use, such as SSH, unless needed.
- Monitoring system logs for suspicious activity.

5. Troubleshooting Common Issues

5.1 Jailbreak Fails to Complete

If the script stops or displays errors, try the following:

- Ensure your Apple TV is on the latest firmware version supported by the jailbreak.

5.2 Device Reboots Unintentionally

5.3 Inability to Connect via SSH

Verify that SSH is enabled in the jailbreak settings. If not, install the SSH tweak from Cydia. Also, confirm that the firewall on your network isn't blocking port 22.

6. Restoring Your Apple TV 3 to Factory Settings

6.1 When to Restore

Restoration is recommended if:

- You want to sell or give away the device.
- The jailbreak causes severe instability.
- You wish to revert to official Apple support.

6.2 How to Restore

1. Connect your Apple TV to a TV and open Settings !' System !' Reset.
2. Choose Restore. This will erase all data and revert the device to factory firmware.
3. After the reset, your Apple TV will boot into the initial setup screen. Reconfigure network and Apple ID settings.
