Once you've reached the desired height, place a flat platform on top of the final step. This gives the staircase an endpoint and can double as a landing or a decorative feature.

## Design Variations

### Wooden Spiral Staircase

Using oak or spruce planks gives a warm, rustic feel. Add a wooden railing and a mossy variant for a natural look.

### Netherite Spiral Staircase

a glowing lantern at the top for extra flair.

## Multi Material Spiral Staircase

Combine materials by alternating between wood and stone on each level. This creates a dynamic pattern that stands out in any build.

## Tips & Tricks for a Professional Look

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- **Use a Grid:** Mark a grid on the ground with chalk or temporary blocks to keep your staircase aligned.
- **Lighting:** Place torches or glowstone at regular intervals to illuminate the staircase and prevent mobs from spawning.
- **Texture Variation:** Mix block types or use slabs to create subtle visual differences between steps.
- **Hidden Doors:** Integrate a hidden door into the railing for secret passages.
