- Basic Sword – Requires 10 Iron Ore and 5 Wood. Grants a +10 attack boost.
- Fire Infused Blade – Requires 8 Iron Ore, 3 Fire Gem, and 5 Wood. Adds fire damage and a +12 attack.
- Ice Sword of the North – Requires 9 Iron Ore, 4 Ice Gem, and 5 Wood. Adds ice damage and a +11 attack.

4.2 Armor Sets

Strong armor can turn the tide of battle. These sets are highly recommended for most players.

- Dragonhide Armor – Requires 6 Dragon Scale, 4 Iron Ore, and 5 Leather. Provides high defense and fire resistance.
- Stormbreaker Plate – Requires 7 Steel Ingot, 3 Storm Crystal, and 5 Leather. Grants defense and a chance to block lightning attacks.
- Shadow Cloak – Requires 5 Shadow Essence, 4 Iron Ore, and 5 Silk. Adds defense and a small chance to dodge attacks.

4.3 Accessories

Accessories are the unsung heroes of your loadout. They offer passive benefits that can drastically improve your survivability.

- Heart of the Dragon – Requires 4 Dragon Scale, 3 Gold Coin, and 2 Silver Coin. Increases HP by 15%.
- Fire Amulet – Requires 3 Fire Gem, 2 Gold Coin, and 1 Silver Coin. Adds fire damage to all attacks.
- Healing Pendant – Requires 4 Healing Herb, 3 Gold Coin, and 2 Silver Coin. Restores a small amount of HP each time you defeat an enemy.

5. Advanced Synthesis Strategies

5.1 Leveling Up Your Synthesis

Every time you successfully craft an item, you earn **synthesis experience points (XP)**. Accumulating XP allows you to increase your synthesis level, unlocking more powerful recipes.

Tips for leveling up quickly:

- Prioritize crafting. Use the synthesis menu frequently, especially when you have surplus materials.
- Focus on high XP recipes. Some items yield more XP per craft. Identify these and craft them often.
- Use “Synthesis Mastery” if available. This feature, unlocked later in the game, lets you craft items without consuming materials, but it does cost a small amount of XP per craft.

3. Choose the Mastery option if it's available.
4. Confirm the craft. The item will appear, and you'll lose a small amount of XP instead.

5.3 Timing and Resource Management

Because materials are scarce, timing is critical. Here's how to manage resources effectively:

- Plan ahead. Keep a list of items you want to craft and the materials needed.
- Stockpile materials. Store excess materials in your inventory or stash for future use.
- Use “Quick Synthesis”. If you're in a hurry, this option lets you craft multiple items in a row without navigating the menu each time.
