### Key Concepts Behind Subtraction with Regrouping

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#### Place Value Recap

Before diving into worksheets, ensure students are comfortable with place value. A quick refresher can include:

- Reading numbers up to 10,000 or higher.
- Identifying the value of each digit (ones, tens, hundreds, thousands).

#### When to Regroup

4. Continue borrowing if necessary. If the lower column still lacks enough value, repeat the process.
5. Subtract normally. Once the lower column has sufficient value, perform the subtraction.

## Common Mistakes and How to Address Them

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- Skipping the borrow step. Students often try to subtract directly, leading to negative digits. Worksheets that explicitly label the borrow step help reinforce the process.
- Misplacing the borrowed value. They may add 10 to the wrong column or forget to reduce the higher column. Visual cues on worksheets, such as highlighted columns, can guide them.
- Inconsistent notation. Using different symbols for borrowing (e.g., a dash, an arrow, or a blank space) can confuse learners. Standardize the notation across all worksheets.
- Failing to check their answer. Encourage a practice of “reverse addition” to verify subtraction results.
