Its name reflects a dual purpose: “Veritasinfo” underscores a commitment to truth and transparency in information, while “Ikaze Iwacu” translates to “Welcome Home” in Kinyarwanda, symbolizing an invitation for all Rwandans to participate in the digital future.

Operating on a model that integrates grassroots participation with professional expertise, Veritasinfo Ikaze Iwacu provides a suite of services ranging from digital literacy workshops to community data hubs. The organization's ethos is grounded in the belief that informed citizens are the foundation of resilient societies, and that data, when made accessible and actionable, can unlock pathways to education, health, and economic opportunity.

Mission & Vision

The mission of Veritasinfo Ikaze Iwacu is to democratize data and digital skills across Rwanda, empowering communities to make evidence based decisions that enhance quality of life. The organization envisions a future where every Rwandan, regardless of geography or socio economic status, can access reliable information, contribute to data collection, and use insights to shape local development.

Key guiding principles include:

- **Transparency:** Open data initiatives that promote accountability.
- **Inclusivity:** Targeted programs for women, youth, and rural populations.
- **Sustainability:** Building local capacity to maintain digital ecosystems.
- **Collaboration:** Partnerships with government, academia, and private sector.

Core Services and Programs

Digital Literacy Initiatives

Digital literacy forms the backbone of Veritasinfo Ikaze Iwacu's outreach strategy. Through a network of community learning centers, the organization offers hands on training covering basic computer skills, internet navigation, and the use of productivity software. These workshops are tailored to the needs of each demographic group, ensuring

that participants not only learn to use technology but also understand its practical applications in daily life.

Youth Empowerment & Innovation Labs

Success Stories

Stories of transformation underscore the tangible benefits of Veritasinfo Ikaze Iwacu's work. One such narrative involves the village of Gihanga, where the community data platform was piloted in 2021.

Prior to the intervention, Gihanga struggled with high infant mortality rates and limited access to clean water. By integrating real time health data and water quality metrics, local leaders were able to prioritize interventions. Within two years, the village saw a 22% reduction in infant mortality and a 30% increase in safe water usage.

Another inspiring case is that of a 19 year old student, Munezero, who participated in the innovation lab. Using data on local fish populations, she developed a mobile app that helped fishermen optimize catch times, resulting in a 10% increase in income for her community.

Future Plans and Vision

Looking ahead, Veritasinfo Ikaze Iwacu aims to scale its impact across the Great Lakes region, expanding the data platform to neighboring countries while tailoring solutions to local contexts. Key strategic priorities include:

- Establishing regional data hubs to facilitate cross border information sharing.
- Launching a mobile first platform that reaches the 70% of Rwandans who access the internet via smartphones.
- Expanding the youth innovation ecosystem to include mentorship in AI and blockchain technologies.

These initiatives align with Rwanda's national Vision 2050, reinforcing the country's trajectory toward a knowledge based economy.
